NEW BASKETBALL LEAGUES FORMAT

Players will learn the basics of basketball including shooting, dribbling, passing, and game rules. Game concepts including offense and defense will be introduced and developed as players' skill levels develop. All skills and equipment will be age appropriate.

No team may participate in another YMCA league with 5 or more of the same players simultaneously. If violated the team will forfeit 1 game, and is subject to dismissal and loss of team fees.

Schedule will be evaluated and is subject to change based on game results. Teams may be moved based off of registration and game results, coaches will be contacted.

All teams must wear YMCA provided jerseys.
