

## **3 vs. 3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT the**

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**



1. All games will be played to 25 points by 2's and 3's. 1 point awarded for all free throws made. A 25 minute time limit will be enforced.
2. Each team will be allowed two 30 second time outs per game.
3. A coin flip will start the game to determine who will take the ball out of bound first.
4. All players must check in at scorer's table prior to the start of each game.
5. Team captain of the winning team on each court, must report to the main table after each game to report game outcome.
6. The out of bounds lines are the black lines.
7. When passing the ball in, player must be behind the red line (further referred to as the red area).
8. All dead balls are taken back to the red area.
9. The ball must be checked by the opposing team.
10. All in-bounds must be passed in to start play.
11. Teams are allowed 10 seconds to put the ball in play.
12. Take back - all defensive rebounds, including airballs, must be taken back to the 3 point arc.
13. Substitutions will be allowed on any dead ball situation.
14. Jump balls will automatically go to the defense (no alternating possessions).
15. All violations and fouls will be consistent with the NDHSAA rules.
16. Referees will call fouls and violations.
17. Fouls
  - a. Team fouls will be assessed consistent with the NDHSAA rules. On the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul, opposing team will be awarded bonus free throws. On the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul, opposing team will be awarded double bonus free throws.
  - b. Personal fouls - Each player will be allowed 4 personal fouls. After 4 personal fouls, each additional foul will be assessed as a technical. 2 free throws and possession of the ball will be awarded to the opposing team, including offensive charges.
18. All shooting fouls will be handled in the following manner; shoot the amount of free throws you are awarded then possession automatically goes to the defense. In case of bonus (one and one) free throws, if the first attempt is made, you get the bonus. If the first attempt is missed, the ball goes to the defense.
19. All non-shooting fouls and violations will be played out of bounds in the red area.
20. In the event of overtime, possession will be determined by a coin toss. Play will be sudden death (the first team to score, wins).
21. We encourage fair play. We discourage rough play.
