6 on 6 Volleyball Rules

The Match

- All Matches will be 3 games to 25 points.
- Teams will be provided a flip scorer to keep score. Both teams need to help keep score.
- Rock, paper, scissors will be used to determine the first serve. Teams will alternate first service for set 2 and 3. Team will switch court sides after each set.
- Six players are allowed on the court at one time. A team must have a minimum of 4 players to begin and continue play during each set.
- Please report match score to the gym supervisor after you play. (Match scores only example: 2-1, set scores are not needed.)

Rotation

- When a team scores a side out, the sub will rotate in for the last server. The new player will enter into the middle back spot.

Violations

Players will be asked to honor call the following:

- **Net violations-** Contact with the net is only a fault if contact is made during the action of playing the ball or if it interferes with play
- **Penetration Under the Net-** It's permitted for a player to step under the net into the opponents court provided that some part of the penetrating hand or foot is in contact with or is directly above the center line.
- **Reaching Over the Net-** Balls cannot be contacted until they have crossed the vertical plane of the net. Reaching over the net and attacking or blocking a ball completely on the opponent's side of the net is a violation.
- **In, Out, and On the Lines-** a ball landing on the line is in. If teams are unable to agree on a line call, please replay the point.
- **Service faults-** At the moment of service contact or take off for a jump serve, the server must not touch the court or the ground outside the service zone. After contact, he/she may step or land outside the service zone or inside the court.
- **Ball handling-** Lifts, double hits, or 4 hits should be called by the player and team that commits the fault.
